Our first adventure will be taking the children back in time beginning with Stone Age Britain...

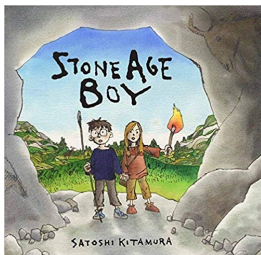
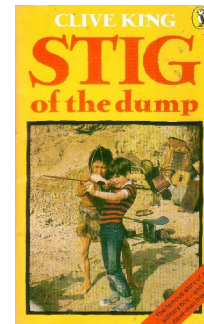


The children will be discovering and learning about what it was like to live in Prehistoric Britain and how our world has changed.
