

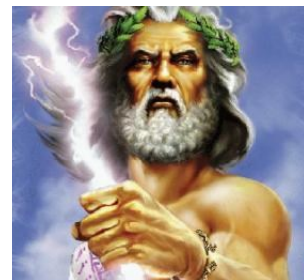
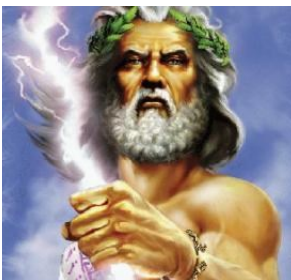


Ancient Greece: It's all Greek to me

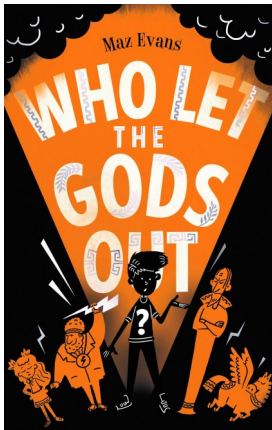


We will work alongside the British Museum to support the learning. As well as this, we will host an Ancient Greece day, whereby children will learn Greek dancing and experience authentic Greek food.



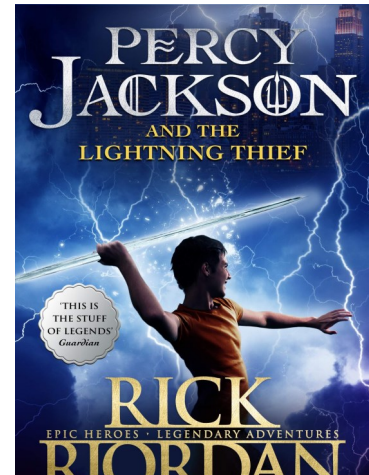
We will be using several texts throughout the topic, including:

In maths, we will be focussing on number, place value and the four operations followed by fractions and geometry.

In science, we will look at the human body as well as living things in their habitats, utilising our outdoor learning areas.
