Dear Parents/ Carers,

We have just entered a second national lockdown: thankfully, the restrictions are less stringent than last time. We are aware that incidents of Covid 19 are rising in East Sussex so we are strictly implementing the government guidelines to ensure the safety of pupils, staff and any parents on site. Nothing has changed at school, but I just want to remind you of what we are doing.

We will continue to teach the curriculum as we are now, keeping as close as possible to our broad curriculum outline. The staff have been very creative and imaginative to ensure that all children have a range of engaging experiences and learning opportunities. Children continue to have their own equipment, whenever possible so minimising contact and any cross contamination. Any shared equipment is regularly sanitised or quarantined.

We ask children to wash or sanitise their hands before, after play and lunch, and at change of activities. Tables are wiped frequently to minimise transmission. Staff also wash their hands and use sanitiser regularly. We do not wear masks in the classrooms, but we do in any communal areas.

This time, the government has said that schools offering wraparound care can continue to do so as long as we can staff it safely. Currently, we are able to run both breakfast and after school club.

The bubble structure is in place to minimise contacts enabling speedy tracing should there be a case of Covid 19. We appreciate you all adhering to these bubbles even though we know they cause some inconvenience for some of you. The staggered starts help to reduce crowding at entrances and in corridors, so reducing contacts.

I would like to take this opportunity to remind you of gates and start of day for each bubble:
