We are pleased to let you know we are now in a position to open up some after school clubs starting in Term 6. Your child's place will be based on a first come, first served basis and if we are at capacity they will be put on a waiting list. To secure a place please book and pay on Parent Pay - the cost is £21.50 for 6 sessions for the Green bubble or £24.50 for 7 sessions for the remaining bubbles - this will cover the cost for term 6. If you will be paying by childcare vouchers or are entitled to a free space, please email clubs@ocklynge.co.uk. We will email you via Edulink to let you know if your child has been successful and gained a place.

Children will be registered in the hall, in their bubble group at the end of the day before the club starts and when the club finishes the children will be released through their usual bubble gate. Please can we ask you to inform us via the booking form on ParentPay, what medical conditions your child has, an emergency contact number and who they will be collected by at the end of the club. Please note children in Years 3 and 4 must be collected by an adult and children in Years
