Our online drawing lessons are set to continue for the second half of the Spring Term as many schools are not yet able to offer after school clubs.

There are three options for you to choose from:

Saturday Club runs from 9.30am to 10.30am each week

Easter Break We are delivering three workshops over the first week of Easter Break as well as the usual Saturday workshops. The sessions are £5 each per session per person. They will be running on Tuesday 6th April, Wednesday 7th April and Thursday 8th April.

The subject will be different each day and the focus will be on watercolour painting/pencils. The classes will start at 10am and finish at 11.30am each day. All ages are welcome.

After School Class Pass For Spring Term 2021 we are offering a new system, a flexible Class Pass (£35) for this 6 week term which means that you can book one class a week on Wednesday, Thursday or Friday. The first class will be Wednesday 21st April and the final Friday class will be 28th May.

Each week we are offering classes on Wednesday at 4.30pm; Thursday 5.30pm and Friday at 5.30pm after school.

This flexibility allows you to book the class that fits in with your plans each week. This fee also covers individual feedback that is delivered via the What's App group. Each class our aim is to help the students to develop their observation, drawing and colour skills and the feedback given via WhatsApp consolidates the process in a positive frame.
